- Great Tew Farms Partnership, The Great Tew Estate, Quarry Farm, Great Tew, Chipping Norton, OX7 4AH for planning permission: extraction of limestone and deposit of imported clay to achieve an agricultural restoration (part retrospective) at Land at Quarry Farm North of Green Lane, Green Lane, Great Tew, OX7 4NS: Ref: MW.0100/21
- Great Tew Farms Partnership, The Great Tew Estate, Quarry Farm, Great Tew, Chipping Norton, OX7 4AH for planning permission: Temporary change of use to mineral processing and storage area at Enstone Airfield North, Land at Enstone Airfield North, Banbury Road, Enstone, OX7 4NS: Ref: MW.0102/21

PLANNING APPLICATION:-

• 7 Cleveley Road, Enstone, 21/02573/OUT – Outline planning application for the erection of four dwellings, closure of existing access and creation of separate access for No. 7 Cleveley Road; new access for the proposed dwellings with parking layout and landscaping scheme (with some matters reserved). Enstone PC has no objection but advises that double yellow lines and bollards are placed at the junction and grass verge and to also consider renewable energy at the properties.

Decisions Received:-

- **Enstone Pre-School** Non-compliance of condition 1 of permission 12/0080 to allow the building to be used by Enstone Pre-school for a further seven years *Approved*
- **Church Cottage, Church Enstone** Conversion of existing barn to create store and games room ancillary to main dwelling *Approved*

CONDOLENCES – Mr. Ian Henderson, former Chair of Enstone PC The Parish Council sends its condolences to Ian's family – Ian sadly passed away at the beginning of August. Ian was Chair of the Council for several years before retiring from this role in May 2011.

DELAY REGARDING WORK AT THE PLANKS

Oxfordshire County Council has informed us that due to both a shortage and delay of materials from the supplier, work to the planks has been delayed.

OVERGROWN VEGETATION:-

Please remember to remove all overgrown vegetation from your property that overhangs public rights of way/pavements/footpaths etc. to ensure that all pathways and rights of way are kept clear.

HEDGEHOG SIGNS

A resident has requested that the Parish Council arranges for "warning – hedgehog" signs be installed along the A44. However, it was agreed that this would not solve the problem and neither would it be an appropriate use of public monies.

PARKING ON VERGES A44

According to the Highway Code (2021), Rule 145 referencing the law made under Road Traffic Act 1988 Section 34 states: "You must not drive on or over a pavement, footpath or bridleway except to gain lawful access to property, or in the case of an emergency" — This is also covered by Section 72 of the Highways Act 1835. Drivers of these vehicles can be given a fine and points for contravening the law. In view of this, the Parish Council requests that residents please refrain from parking on verges, particularly along the A44.

GIGACLEAR IN ENSTONE

The Parish Council has contacted Gigaclear for further information regarding the works in Enstone. The County Council has informed the Parish Council that Chapel Lane will be closed for a month from 25th October to 24th November, for Gigaclear to undertake cable works. The Parish Council has asked for further clarity on this from Gigaclear and how residents will access their properties. Work along The Drive has begun but, apparently, no residents received any communication regarding this.

DEFIBRILLATOR TRAINING:-

Enstone Parish Council is organising a further training session on how to use the defibrillator which is situated outside Enstone House. This will take place in October and further details will be in September's magazine.
