Temporary Footpath closure between The Lodge & Wychwood House

A request has been received from J N Bentley for a temporary footpath closure to apply to a section of footpath between The Lodge and Wychwood House whilst essential below ground Thames Water sewer pipeline replacement works are carried out. A Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) is being made

to implement the temporary closure and will operate from 16 December 2021 up to and including 17 March 2022. **This is a 24 hour footpath closure.**

Deadline Saturday 13th November 2021
