

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**The Oxfordshire County Council,
Enstone Footpath No. 18 (part),
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification
Order 2022.**

This Order is made by The Oxfordshire County Council ('the authority') under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the public and in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the public right of way described in Article 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

West Oxfordshire District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the Highways Act 1980.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Lime View in the parish of Enstone and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished on the date upon which Oxfordshire County Council certifies that the route described in paragraph 2 (below) has been brought into a fit condition for use by the public and thereupon the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
2. There shall be from the date of confirmation a public footpath over the land situated at Lime View in the parish of Enstone (as described in Part 2 of the Schedule) and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the Oxfordshire County Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire shall be modified by adding that right of way to it, and the Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

3. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in Article 1 above shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the date of this Order.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING WAY

Enstone Footpath No. 18

The entire width of Enstone FP No. 18 running from OS Grid Ref SP 3767 2493 (Point A on the Order plan) south-westwards for approximately 44m to SP 3764 2491 (Point B) and generally west-south-westwards for approximately 54m to SP 3758 2491 (Point C).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW WAY

Enstone Footpath No. 18

A new footpath with a width of 2m running from OS Grid Ref SP 3767 2493 (Point A on the Order plan) north-north-westwards for approximately 13m to SP 3767 2494 (Point D), west-south-westwards for approximately 4m to SP 3768 2494 (Point E), generally south-westwards for approximately 48m to SP 3762 4292 (Point Z), generally west-north-westwards for approximately 34m to SP 3759 2492 (Point G), south-westwards for approximately 2m to SP 37595 24929 (Point H), southwards for approximately 6m to SP 37594 24922 (Point I), and south-westwards for approximately 12m to SP 3758 2491 (Point C).

Approximate route of unaffected rights of way

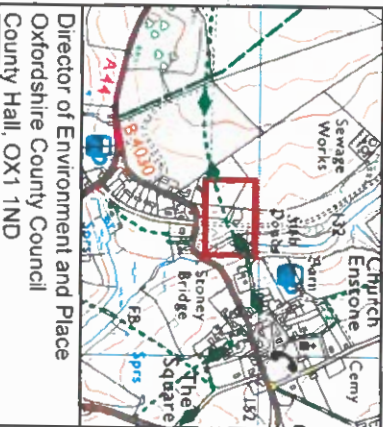

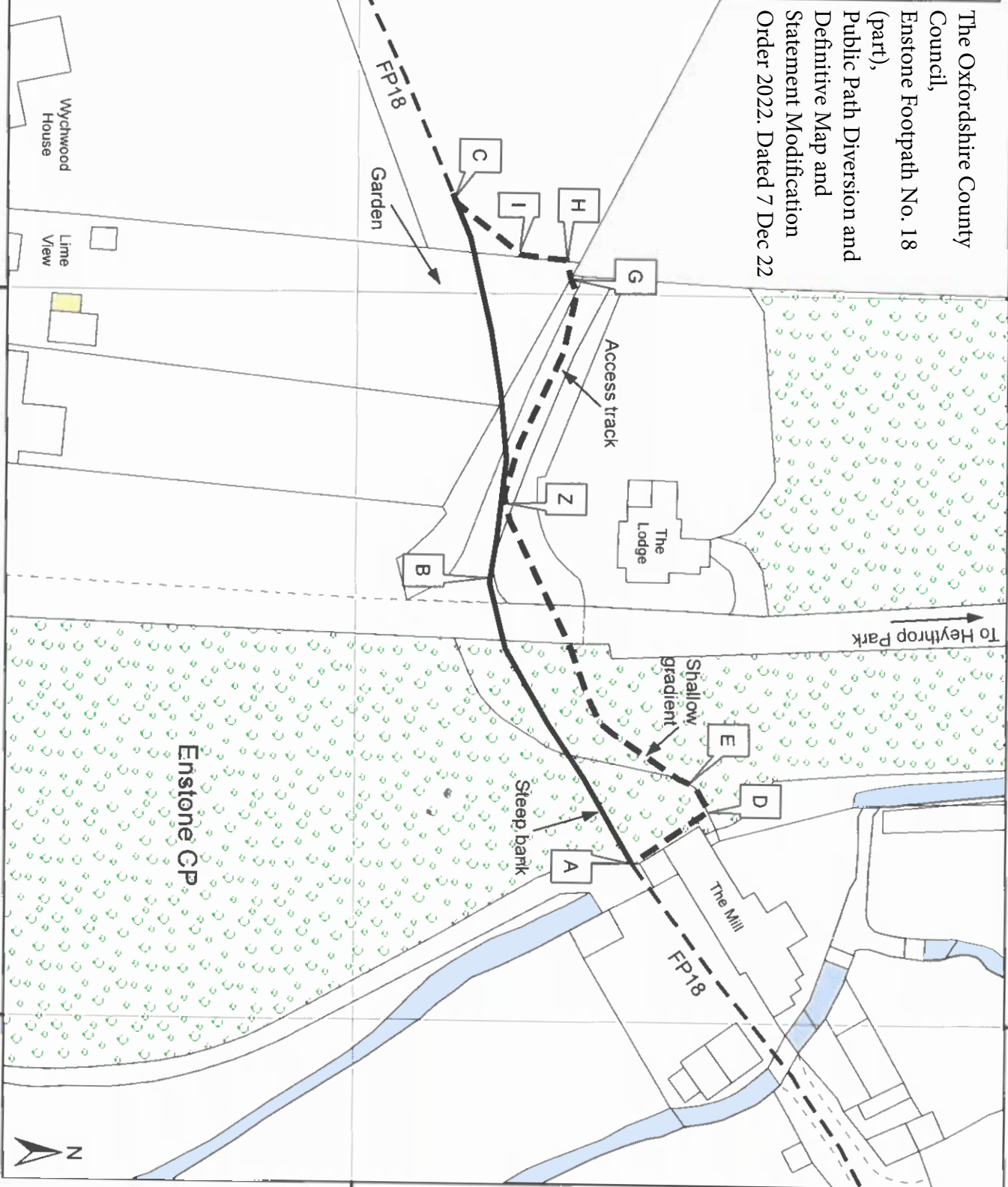
