OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ENSTONE AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 202*

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 & 84, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Enstone Area) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
- 2. The roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall not be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
- 4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
- 5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this order.
- 6. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this order.
- 7. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 8. The Oxfordshire County Council (Enstone Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2023 is hereby revoked/replaced.
