

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(ENSTONE AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 202\***

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 & 84, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Enstone Area) (Speed Limits) Order 202\* and shall come into force on the     day of     202\*.
2. The roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall not be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this order.
6. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this order.
7. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
8. The Oxfordshire County Council (Enstone Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2023 is hereby revoked/replaced.

j)	Litchfield Close	for its entire length	
k)	Mill Lane	for its entire length	
l)	Quarry Close	for its entire length	
m)	The Rise	for its entire length	
n)	The Spinneys	for its entire length	

## Cleveley

The whole length of every road in the hamlet of Cleveley (excluding any lengths of road specified in schedules 2, 3 or 4) leading out to the following points:

a)	unnamed road from Cleveley to Enstone	to a point 85 metres west of the unnamed lane to Langton House
b)	unnamed road from Cleveley to the A44 Oxford Road	a point 235 metres south of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford

c)	unnamed road from Cleveley to Radford	a point 60 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road to the A44 Oxford Road.

### Gagingwell

a)	B4030	from a point 464 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford, east & northwards	to a point 135 metres northeast of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford
b)	Unnamed road to Radford	from its junction with the B4030, southwards	for a distance of 120 metres.

### Lidstone

a)	Lidstone Road	from its junction with the unnamed road to the A44 Oxford Road, eastwards	for a distance of 115 metres.
b)	unnamed road from Lidstone to the A44 Oxford Road	from its junction with Lidstone Road, northwards	to a point 403 metres south of its junction with the A44

### Radford

a)	unnamed road to Cleveley	from a point 85 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road to Kiddington, eastwards	for its entire length
b)	unnamed road to Kiddington	from its junction with the unnamed road to Cleveley, southwards	for a distance of 80 metres.

## SCHEDULE 1-2

30mph speed limit:

### Enstone

The whole length of every road in the village of Enstone extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the said village) to the following points:

a)	A44 Oxford Road (north-western end)	a point 162 metres northwest of its junction with the B4030 Bicester Road.

e)	B4030 Bicester Road	a point 37 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road running north-westwards to Little Tew.
f)	Cox's Lane	a point 155 metres southeast of its junction with The Spinney.
g)	Lidstone Road	a point 150 metres west of its junction with Cox's Lane.

a)	A44 Oxford Road (Northern end)	from a point 45 metres northwest of its junction with the northern junction of Chapel Lane, north-westwards	to a point 162 metres northwest of its junction with the B4030 Bicester Road
b)	A44 Oxford Road (Southern end)	from a point 85 metres northwest of its junction with Cleveley Road, south-eastwards	to a point 147 metres southeast of its junction with the B4022 to Charlbury
c)	B4022 to Charlbury	from its junction with the A44 Oxford Road, south-westwards	to a point 65 metres southwest of its junction with Cox's Lane
d)	Cox's Lane	from its junction with the B4022 to Charlbury, northwards	for a distance of 115 metres.

### Gagingwell

h)	B4030 Enstone/Middle Barton Road.	from a point 135 metres northeast of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford in a general westerly direction for a distance of 599 metres.

## Lidstone

i)	The unclassified road looping south off the A44 running through Lidstone	from a point 403 metres south of its junction with the A44 in a general southerly direction for a distance of 553 metres.

### **SCHEDULE 2 3**

40mph speed limit:

(a)	B4022	from the terminal point of the 30mph speed limit— a point 28 metres north of its junction with Cleveley Road, northwards	to a point 50 metres north of its junction with the B4030.
(b)	B4030	from the terminal point of the 30mph speed limit a point 37 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road running north-westwards to Little Tew, eastwards	for 300 metres.

### **SCHEDULE 3 4**

50mph speed limit:

#### **B4030 Enstone/Middle Barton Road**

a)	from a point 337 east of its junction with the B4022 to Little Tew, eastwards	to a point 464 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford
b)	from a point 135 metres northeast of its junction with the unnamed road to Radford, north & eastwards	to its junction with Laundry Lane in the parish of Sandford St Martin.
